The Alvis Stormer is a modern military armoured vehicle which was manufactured by Alvis Vickers, now part of BAE Systems Global Combat Systems. The Stormer vehicle was developed to provide a mobile platform for the Starstreak High Velocity Missile (HVM) system for detachment level protection and excellent mobility with eight ready to fire missiles and a further nine stowed inside. The HVM system is a low level Close Air Defence (CAD) system with a rapid engagement capacity developed and optimised to counter the Attack Helicopter threat. This is the Troop Reconnaissance variant of the platform, having never been fitted with a launcher, but used in command and control of the Battery. Anbsp; The Stormer is a development of the CVR(T) family of vehicles (Scorpion, Scimitar, Spartan etc.), essentially a larger, modernised version with an extra road-wheel on each side.
